

Six automatic Swiss-embroidery looms, four pattern punching and three pattern duplicating machines and more than two score auxiliary machines comprise our park of modern highly efficient machinery having a value in excess of two handred thousand dollars.

In our modern well organized factory (12,300 sq. ft.) more than fifty competent craftsmen and craftswamen are interested to see your orders filled to your every satisfaction.

Popular emblems for automotive, gasoline, tire, brewery, soft drink and other industries are stocked to fill almost ony order the same day. Requests for special emblems can be filled within a relatively short time.

Comparison of our price list with similar price lists shows that our prices are in line. The materials we use in the manufacture of A-8 emblems are always the best available and the workmanklip is superior.

Our oritist and designers hore vari experience in assisting you to develop your ideas for emblems. They will, following your instructions closely, prepare colored skeldess, which together with actual samples of the motorial, are sent to you for approvin. In this connection it is important to be mindful of the fact that bold and simple designs are always more effective and legible than finely detailed designs.

... Do not use too many colors . . . Shorten slogans and long firm names to a minimum of words . . . Keep your design clear and clean . . . Use plain shapes . . . . Circles, ovals, squares, oblongs, diamonds can driangles are much better had fancy shapes. The simpler shapes are easy to sew on the uniform. The fancy shapes present a little difficulty in attaching to the uniform.

From the opproved colored starth, we make a drawing of your design. With the help of color lartes and enterging commers, we blow-up your statch to exactly sit fines it a size. The entergred drawing on special pages to prevent shrinking or wrelling, shows every statch of embrodiety your emblem will contain when faithed. An entergret receives four years of training. We have the best entorgers in the trades. Illustration No. I inside of front over shows the founds of on entorces or work.

The enlarged drawing of your emblien goes to the Swiss embroidery cord punder. He operates a pattern punding modifiers a very, very complicated piece of modifiery. A lifetime of experience is necessiry to develop a highly skilled punder. Our punders possess immeasurable skill and are the highest poid men in the trade. Blustration No.2 initials of front cover shows a punder of work.

The product of the punching modiline is a roll of popes similar to the rolls of the old player piezons. Every liftle hole is this roll, and there are mony finances, but no perform a distinct function. The length of the punching roll and the amount of belse depend on the content of embroiding staticles your emblem contains. This punching page on on the outeraction of the dependent of the Swiss embroiding from Illustration No.3 inside of boot covers shows the more important ports of the outeraction.

Let us stop here first and explain what a Swiss embroidery loom is. An embroidery loom is surely one of the most complicated textile machines. It's history goes back to the 1860's

when Jacob Groebili, a most ingenious Swiss inventor, came up with the idea of embroidering materials on a machine with needle and shuttle. Up to that time all embroidery was done by hond with one needle and one thread.

The Swiss embroidery loom is a tremendous machine. It is built in two lengths. One has a total length of 59 feet with a working length of 15 yards. The more popular and shorter machine is 44 feet long with a working length of 10 yards. The height of these machines is almost 14 feet. They have a depth of 8 feet and weigh a minimum of 10 tons. (Picture No. 4 inside of back cover illustrates a 10 yard machine in operation.) The great weight, the tremendous working length and the fact that there are two working levels makes it imperative that these machines are erected on concrete pillars and that the footings are encased in cement. To dismantle, move and re-erect one Swiss loom takes highly skilled erectors 6 to 8 weeks and costs approximately five thousand dollars. While we are concerned about costs, it might be of interest to mention that a general overhoul of one Swiss loom may cost as much as ten thousand dollars. We now know that the machines are large, long and heavy, that they are very complex and have working lengths of ten and 15 yards. How do these tremendous machines manufacture embroidered emblems? Running the lengths of the machine and hung between the needle and shuttle rails there is a huge frame. This frame has two sections, one for the upper and one for the lower level. We span two pieces of cloth, each measuring 101/2 or 151/2 yards long depending on the length of the machine. To make the emblems stronger, we span equally long pieces of buckram in back of the basecloth. Usually the base cloth is cotton uniform twill. The twills we use are always fast to washing and otherwise of highest quality. Facing the machine from the operators side, we see two pieces of base material running the length of the machine. In the machine we see banks of needles and spools of thread. Each color of thread in the machine necessitates a change of all spools and rethreading all needles. (Each color change increases the price of the emblem.) In back of the material is the shuttle tenders side of the machine. There we see little shuttles containing the bobbins. There is, of course, one shuttle for each needle. The 15 yard machine employs a maximum of 512 needles and the 10 yard machine 342.

After the necessary shettles, needles and spools of thread have been put into the machine and the basecloth and the budram has been spanned, and after the punching roll has been inserted into the automat, then the Swiss Ioom is ready to roll.

The automatic attachment, an integral part of the modern Swiss loom, was invented by the son of the inventor of the Swiss loom. With the advert of the automat, the Swiss embroidery industry was launched to become a world-wide industry.


When ordering emblems that have to be made up special this procedure should be followed.

Prepare a rough sketch indicating Coloring, Detail and Size. When drawing the size and shape of the emblem do not forget to allow at least  $^{1}$ /a inch for the border all around the emblem.

Special emblems should be ordered according to the guide listed below. All figures listed are minimum runs that our machines produce. Smaller quantities can be ordered but are, of course, considerably higher in price.
